

Project Jack: FAQs

What time will the application open?

The online application form will open at 6:30 am on Monday, January 9th. Applications filled out prior to 6:30 am will not be accepted.

What is needed for the application?

Teacher Name
School Name
School District
School Address for mailing of the check
Teacher's phone number
Email address
Short description of the project.*

*Details must be received by January 20, 5:00pm or the application will be forfeited.

What are the requirements for the projects. What will not be accepted?

- Only 5th grade classes
- Must be a pay it forward type of project. It must benefit another person or go to an organization that is helping lowans in need.
- Must remain in Iowa. Out-of-state or international projects will not be accepted.
 - *Exception would be for lowans serving in the military*
 - *Exception made for Iowa towns on the border that might be serving lowans and others in adjacent state. For example, a project helping patients at Children's Hospital in Omaha would be acceptable.*
- Cannot go towards equipment for school (ie. musical instruments, sports equipment, etc.)

When and how will the teachers be notified?

- Teachers will be notified by email on or before January 23.
- There will be a wait list
- Checks will be distributed by February 10.

When does the Project Need to be completed?

Projects must be completed by April 15 of the current school year (2017). If more time is needed due to uncontrollable factors, weather, etc. this can be addressed on a case-by-case basis.
